## Discover family activities and interactive stations throughout the museum!

**Feed the Fish (21):** Daily, 12:30 p.m. Learn more about trout species and fish stocking while feeding the fish. *All ages.*



**Wash Day (10):** Daily. Pump water, pound and scrub with old fashioned tools. *Toddler – Preschool, School age.*

**Merwin Hill Pavilion (17):** Daily. Enjoy rustic games, wooden puzzles, and building blocks. *School age.*

**The Reising Schoolhouse (10):** Daily. Play games and make projects that Adirondack school children have enjoyed for generations. *All ages.*



**Little Log Cabin and Tot Lot (10):** Daily. Young visitors can swing, climb, play and explore our Adirondack playground and child-sized cabin. *Toddler – Preschool, School age.*



**Boat Builder's Demonstration (1):** Saturday – Wednesday, June 11 – August 15, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Watch as an Adirondack guideboat takes form. *All ages. (Note: Boatbuilder will be out July 7–15)*



**Rowing on the Pond (21):** Daily, mid-June – mid-September. Take a ride in a Bisby scow. *All ages.*

**Film (C):** Daily, *The Adirondacks: Lives and Times of an American Wilderness.* *Adult.*
